

# CIVIL ENGINEERING, GRADUATE CERTIFICATE

## Admission Requirements

Applicants who are interested in taking graduate-level courses, but not necessarily interested in pursuing a full master's degree are eligible for the Graduate Certificate in Civil Engineering. Admission requirements for the Graduate Certificate in Civil Engineering are the same as those for the Master of Civil Engineering (<http://e-catalog.jhu.edu/engineering/engineering-professionals/civil-engineering/civil-engineering-master-civil-engineering/>).

Once matriculated, if a student should later decide to pursue the full master's degree, all successfully completed courses will apply provided they meet program requirements and that the remaining courses to be completed fall within a five-year time limit. The student must declare their intention prior to completing the certificate.

## Program Requirements

Five courses must be completed within three years. Each student will work with the program chair to design a program tailored to meet their individual goals. Focus areas are not available for students pursuing certificates. All course selections are subject to advisor approval.
