

MECHANICAL ENGINEERING, POST-MASTER'S CERTIFICATE

Admission Requirements

Applicants who have already completed a master's degree in a closely related discipline are eligible to apply for the Post-Master's Certificate in Mechanical Engineering.

Program Requirements

Five courses must be completed within five years. At least four of the five courses must be from the Mechanical Engineering (<https://e-catalogue.jhu.edu/engineering/engineering-professionals/mechanical-engineering/mechanical-engineering-master-science/#requirements>) (EN.535.XXX) program, and at least two of the courses must be at the 700-level. Certificate students may not enroll in graduate research courses (EN.530.800 Independent Study, EN.535.820 Master's Graduate Research, or EN.535.821 Master's Graduate Thesis).

Only grades of B– or above can count toward the post-master's certificate. Courses from the full-time program (530.xxx) may be substituted subject to advisor approval. Focus areas are not applicable to students pursuing certificates. Students are free to choose any five courses offered by the Mechanical Engineering program. All course selections outside of the Mechanical Engineering program are subject to advisor approval.
