

DIRECTED STUDIES MINOR PLAN

For the Directed Studies minor, students devise a Directed Study Plan in an area of study that is comprised of 21 credits:

- 15 credits taken at another JHU division
- 6 credits taken at Peabody, and/or another JHU division, and/or or another institution through the Baltimore Student Exchange Program or awarded through [Peabody's transfer credit policy](#)

Credits earned from AP, IB, or study prior to entering Peabody cannot be applied. Plans must adhere to the semester limit of 25 credits.

To craft their plans, students can consider and consult:

- Prior experiences and coursework
- Interests in specific fields
- Academic and professional goals
- Connections to their Peabody major
- Homewood minors and their course requirements
- SIS course offerings at the various JHU divisions

Students may consult with the Chair of Liberal Arts and/or Academic Advising in the preparation of their plans.

Students must submit their Study Plan for approval to the Chair of Liberal Arts as early as the end of the first semester of study, but no later than the fourth semester of study. Any revisions to plans require on-going approval from the Chair of Liberal Arts.

Courses in approved Study Plans may replace any Core 3 and Core 4 requirements and may fulfill Liberal Arts Electives. Approval may also be granted for minor courses to replace Core 1 and Core 2 if they have sufficient content in text analysis, writing and research methods.
