***Requirements for successful completion:**

The certificate requires a minimum of 18 academic credits: 9 credits from required gerontology courses and 9 credits from the elective courses. In order to be certified as complete, all courses must be taken for a letter grade, and students must maintain a minimum 2.75 grade point average in all gerontology courses. Requirements must be completed within a three-year period. Degree seeking students MAY NOT complete the certificate after their degrees are earned; **all certificate courses must be completed prior to graduation.**
