• The certificate requires a minimum of 18 academic credits, including the required Seminar in Health Disparities course, two terms of the Health Disparities Journal Club course, and taking thirteen or more credits from the elective courses. In order to be certified as complete, all courses must be taken for letter grade, and students must maintain a minimum 2.75 GPA. Requirements must be completed within a three-year period.
