***Requirements for successful completion:**

The certificate requires a minimum of 20 academic credits which will include 3 required courses, 2 courses in a specific content area of injury, and at least 2 courses related to one or more injury control strategies. In order to be certified as complete all courses (except for the Graduate Seminar) must be taken for letter grade, and students must maintain a minimum 2.75 GPA in all certificate courses. Requirements must be completed within a three-year period. Degree seeking students MAY NOT complete the certificate after their degrees are earned; **all certificate courses must be completed prior to graduation.**
