ELECTRICAL AND COMPUTER ENGINEERING, POST-MASTER'S CERTIFICATE

Admission Requirements

Applicants who have already completed a master's degree in a closely related technical discipline are eligible to apply for the Post-Master's Certificate in Electrical and Computer Engineering.

Program Requirements

Five courses must be completed within five years. At least four of the five courses must be from the Electrical and Computer Engineering (EN.525.xxx) program or the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering (EN.520.xxx) in the full-time program and at least two of the four required Electrical and Computer Engineering courses must be 700-level. Students are allowed to take one elective. Only grades of B— or above can count toward the post-master's certificate. All course selections outside of Electrical and Computer Engineering program requirements are subject to advisor approval.
